

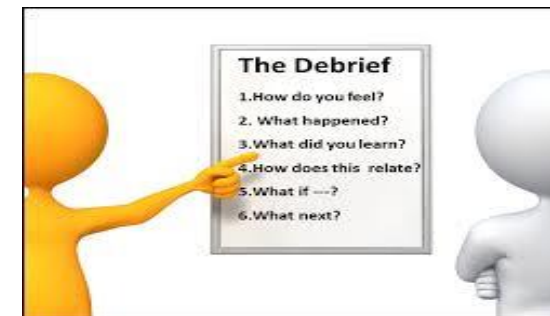
INTRODUCTION TO SIMULATION & BASICS OF DEBRIEFING
